## CONSOLIDATION OF CARRIER IMPOSED CHARGE AMOUNTS (YR AND YQ-I)

In order to streamline revenue reporting, please take note that effective 1<sup>st</sup> October 2022, KQ will consolidate its carrier-imposed charges YR and YQ-I into one amount *to be referred to as YR*. This implies that all previously filed KQ sector based YQ-I amounts will cease to exist.

However, the recently introduced GDS surcharge, **YQ-F** will remain in the tickets issued by Travel Agents. It is important to note that these adjustments will not impact the total fare paid by the customer. Below is an illustration of the scenario before and after the changes (using a round trip fare on TLSRKE fare basis Nairobi – Kisumu).

## Please take note of the following:

- All non-ticketed bookings will be impacted by the change. However, the all-in fare amount will not change.
- For reissues, new YR will be applied this is to avoid carrying over the old YQ to newly reissued tickets.
