

What are the pre-flight Covid-19 test requirements?

Proflight does not give out information on testing facilities, please contact the government Department/Ministry of Health for advice and further questions. There are currently no exemptions to requirements for vaccinated travellers.

To enter South Africa, you are required to present a printed COVID-19 PCR negative certificate in order to check-in for your flight in Zambia. The following must appear on the document:

- passenger passport name (first name and surname)
- “PCR negative test result” or “COVID-19 negative test certificate”
- Test date/time is within 72 hours of flight departure
- Medical practitioner name, signature, stamp
- Passengers using international-transit-without-visa facility at Joburg must also adhere to these regulations
- Children aged 5 years and under are EXEMPT from this entry requirement into SA
- **To exit Zambia** 1)MOH SARS-CoV-2 Medical Certificate for International Travel AND 2)African Union Trusted Travel Platform TT code required for all passengers exiting Zambia to a country with covid test requirement. This certificate and code will be verified by Port Health at Lusaka airport, prior to allowing the passenger to proceed to international airline check-in counters. Please ensure you have this certificate and code printed to accompany your test result else you will not be permitted to proceed to check-in.
- For covid-recoveries within past 90 days, the exemption of this negative PCR test is now allowed provided the passenger has received/printed their exemption letter from SA Dept of Health/Port Health
 - Email to porthealth.travel@health.gov.za as earlier as possible before travel
 - Time between covid-positive PCR test and travel date cannot exceed 90 days
 - Submit in the email your passport copy, covid-positive PCR test results and a letter issued by medical practitioner showing that you have fully recovered, are not experiencing any new symptoms and you are fit to travel. This letter must contain passenger passport name, medical practitioner name with their physical address, contact details, signature, stamp

To enter Zambia, you are required to present a printed SARS CoV2 PCR negative test result in order to checkin for your flight in South Africa. The following must appear on the document:

- passenger passport name (first name and surname)
- “PCR negative test result” or “COVID-19 negative test certificate”
- Test date is within 72 hours of flight departure from the country of origin
- Children aged 5 years and under are EXEMPT from this entry requirement into Zambia

When should I go for my Covid-19 test?

What happens if I test positive on my pre-flight Covid-19 result?

If you receive a positive lab result within seven days of your flight date, we will waive the potential upward fare difference to rebook at a late date. The only payment due at the time you are ready to rebook will be the \$25 Change fee if you are ticketed on Firecracker fare class. To apply for this, the passenger or travel agent must contact Proflight Reservations to cancel your seat at least two hours prior to flight departure and must send us the passenger’s positive test result at the same time.

Is there quarantine on arrival?

There is currently no published quarantine for entry into Zambia nor South Africa. All passengers are subject to medical screening upon arrival and could be subject to a COVID test upon arrival at their own expense.

What COVID measures do I expect on day of travel?

Please carry your completed/printed inbound SA or Zambia Passenger Health Form for each passenger even children/infants. This form is available for printing during our online check-in process, onboard your flight or on our website under Planning/Travel Documents. By law, all passengers older than five years must provide and wear their own masks at check-in, boarding and for the duration of the flight. Hand sanitizers and wipes are available on board.
