PIRAEUS (ATHENS) TO DUBROVNIK

VISITS: Monemvasia; Itea (Delphi); Nydri (Lefkada); Kerkira (Corfu); Gallipoli (Italy); Kotor (Montenegro); Vis; Dubrovnik.

From Athens sail to Monemvasia, still considered Greece's best-preserved Byzantine city, with impressive churches, restored palaces, vaulted alleys and city walls. Visit Delphi, once home to the legendary Oracle, then call into the picturesque Ionian yacht harbour of Nydri, from where you may explore vast olive groves and the famous waterfalls. Next is verdant Corfu, its old town surrounded by orchards of lemon and orange trees, cypress, oleander, and myrtle bushes. Gallipoli in Italy's boot is a delight, a pretty baroque coastal town with a 'Centro Storico', dominated by a 13th century Byzantine castle. Cruise into medieval Kotor via the Gulf of Kotor, offering one of the Mediterranean's most beautiful landscapes. Learn about the fascinating history of Vis Island, a designated UNESCO Global Geopark and biodiverse haven for bottlenose dolphins, devil rays, and blue-fin tuna, before you arrive into Dubrovnik.

Visits: Korcula (Croatia); Zadar; Opatija; Koper (Slovenia); Hvar; Dubrovnik.

This roundtrip Dubrovnik cruise features the highlights of the Adriatic. Korcula, rumoured to be birthplace of Marco Polo, is a classic medieval Dalmatian walled stone town with round towers and red-tiled roofs, perfect for strolling through narrow cobblestone byways and discovering tiny plazas. Founded by the Romans, attacked by the Turks, ruled by the Austrians then made part of Italy until 1943, Zadar is one of the Adriatic's most historically interesting towns with a wealth of sightseeing and exciting nightlife. With its breath-taking views over the Adriatic and towards the Istrian mountains in the distance, Opatija is a place of natural beauty. earning the welldeserved title, "The Adriatic Nice". Koper in Slovenia is gateway to the pretty bijou capital of Ljubljana, while the golden isle of Hvar boasts more UNESCO World Heritage sites than any other island in the world, as well as golden beaches. *Lead fare based on 23/6/24

DUBROVNIK TO PIRAEUS (ATHENS)

From Sarande tour to ancient Butrint, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with extensive ruins dating from prehistory, though Greek, Roman and Byzantine periods, until medieval times. Zakynthos is the archetypal pretty Greek island, while Nafplion is gateway to the ancient sites of Mycenae and Epidaurus.
