The easternmost and third-largest island of Cape Verde definitely does justice to its name – Boa Vista: beautiful view. Life on this island is authentic and the landscape is characterized by deserts of sand and scree.

Our excursion will take us to small villages, where we will have the opportunity to see every day's life and the special nature of this island. First we will wonder the streets of Sal Rei and take in the atmosphere of the capital, after this we go to Rabil to visit a local school for traditional pottery. See local artisans creating decorative pieces with their home clay followed by a drive in the Viana Desert (short stop).

We will also have the opportunity to swim in the ocean at the natural beach of Santa Monica weather permitting, followed by a good local lunch.

Our last highlight will be the old Shipwreck at Santa Maria beach before returning to our ship.

Note: Guests are seated both inside/outside at the pickups with rotation during the tour; (heat/sun/sand)

SAO VICENTE: MINDELO: Culture City walk

• Duration approx. 4 hours • Incl. Guide

MINDELO is known as the cultural capital of the country. We will go on a discovery tour of the lively markets and the secret corners of the harbor town. On this tour you will be walking towards the harbor along the famous of MINDELO bay RUA DE PRAIA with traditional shops and monuments like and you will see the cultural centre, (former customs) and the fish market. You will also visit of the African market PRACA ESTRELA passing a traditional quarter, with the town hall, and the vegetable market. Before returning to the pier, you will pass the historical main street RUA LISBOA and the very lively PRACA NOVA - Free time for shopping.

Lying about one mile to the north-east of Praslin, this island of about 2 miles long was first given the name Ile Rouge on account of its red earthway across the island, notably through the extensive swamps, home to eight different species of mangrove (more info on Shore Excursions document).

Please Note: Tour involves a moderate amount of physical activity such as walking over an uneven surface, climbing stairs or steep terrain. Not recommended for guests with walking difficulties.

COUSIN, ANSE LAZIO | Escorted walking tour by a local ranger, duration approximately 1,5hrs | Zodiac to shore by the local rangers: wet landing | Landing, conservation and visiting fees are included in our cruise fare

Cousin Island is a granitic island covering 27 hectares and lies approximately 2km from Praslin Island. It became the world's first internationally owned-reserve when it was purchased in 1968 by the International Council for the Protection of Birds (ICBP), now Birdlife International (more info on Shore Excursions document).

MOYENNE | Escorted walking tour, duration approximately 1,15 hrs | Zodiac to shore: wet landing | Landing, conservation and visiting fees are included in our cruise fare

Brendon Grimshaw purchased the island for £10,000 in 1962 and set about making the island habitable. He did this with the help of one other man, Rene Antoine Lafortune (more info on Shore Excursions document).

ARIDE – ST PIERRE – RASLIN | Escorted walking tour by a local ranger, duration approximately 1,5hrs | Zodiac by local rangers to shore: wet landing | Landing, conservation and visiting fees are included in our cruise fare

A visit to Aride Island is an essential part of the itinerary for any visitor to Seychelles to discover what the islands were like 250 years ago before human settlement(more info on Shore Excursions document).

Please Note: The escorted tour is easy to moderate. Much of the tour is on foot; comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Temperature or humidity can be high, take sun block protection, hat, repellent, sunglasses and water with you. Aride is often closed for a visit during the South East Trade winds (May to September as an average), it may also close at short notice during strong urf or during various bird nesting seasons.

Discover the villages of FAREPITI, FAANUI, and ANAU with their mysterious "Marae". As you travel on, you will discover the MATIRA point with its spectacular view. The road continues & takes you along coconut groves and tiny villages along the shoreline.

MOOREA, "ISLAND TOUR & BELVEDERE

Duration 3,5 hrs, Min. 6 pax – Max. 8 per vehicle up to 8/9 vehicles

Hop on your air-conditioned motorcoach for an enjoyable tour around the island of Moorea as your guide relates entertaining stories about the island's history, culture and ecology and travel along Moorea's lush Opunohu Valley. The valley is home to a number of Polynesian marae or an open-air temple. Ascend the slopes of Mt. Tohi'e'a and continue pass Cook's and Opunohu Bays. A stop will be made at Moorea Fruit Juice Factory, where you can buy fresh juices made from locally grown fruits. The factory also produces an assortment of fruit brandies and liquers in a variety of flavours including star fruit, ginger, papaya, mango, orange, grapefruit, coconut and pineapple.

PHOTO OPPORTUNITIES (Moorea Highlights tour)

Marae – Stop at the massive ancient Polynesian marae, an open-air stone temple in the Opunohu Valley.

Le Belvedere – The summit of Mt. Tohi'e'a boasts panoramas of Moorea's mountains and Cook's and Opunohu Bays.

Toatea Lookout – The Lookout has sweeping views of Moorea's lagoon with Tahiti in the background.

Protestant Church – First church in French Polynesia constructed in 1822.
