DAY 1- FRIDAY | DUBROVNIK, CROATIA

Embarkation Day

Your Adriatic journey begins in Dubrovnik, the legendary Pearl of the Adriatic and one of Europe's most magnificent UNESCO World Heritage cities. Embark **M/Y Callisto** at **Gruž Port** from **14:00**, where you'll be warmly welcomed by our Captain and crew. Settle into your comfortable cabin and begin discovering the relaxed rhythm of life aboard your boutique yacht—your home at sea for the week ahead. This afternoon, join our included guided walking tour through Dubrovnik's enchanting Old Town. Wander along the famous Stradun, admire centuries-old palaces, churches and fountains, and discover the remarkable story of the former Republic of Ragusa, one of the Mediterranean's great maritime powers. Back onboard, meet your fellow travellers during a Welcome Cocktail Reception before enjoying your first dinner featuring fresh Mediterranean flavours and regional wines. As the lights begin to illuminate Dubrovnik's ancient walls, your unforgettable island-hopping adventure officially begins.

DAY 2 - SATURDAY | ELAPHITI ISLANDS & MLJET

First Island-Hopping Day and Variety Swim Stop Experience

This morning Callisto sails northwest from Dubrovnik toward the Elaphiti Islands, a peaceful archipelago of pine-covered islands, stone villages, sheltered bays and clear Adriatic waters. Here, away from the larger cruise routes, you'll experience the slower rhythm that defines boutique yachting. Your Captain drops anchor in the sheltered waters off Šipanska Luka for your first Variety Swim Experience.

Itineraries can be changed at the discretion of Variety Cruises and of the Vessel's Captain in case of adverse weather conditions - winds of 6/7 Beaufort or more depending on the vessel- on port authorities not allowing a vessel to leave port or in case of other extraordinary conditions. Such itinerary changes do not automatically entitle passengers to any refunds, but Variety Cruises guarantees that passengers are disembarked at the advertised port of disembarkation on time for their flights.

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Dive directly from the yacht into crystal-clear turquoise waters, enjoy a leisurely swim or simply relax on deck as Callisto drifts gently in one of the Adriatic's most beautiful natural anchorages. Later, the yacht continues to Mljet, one of Croatia's greenest islands and home to the famous Mljet National Park. On arrival, our Chief Experience Officer will take you for a stroll to visit the famous salt lakes, situated in the heart of the park. This evening, enjoy dinner at your leisure and discover the flavours of Mljet. Choose one of Pomena's welcoming family-run tavernas and savour freshly caught Adriatic seafood, locally produced olive oil and traditional Dalmatian specialities while watching the sun set over the tranquil harbour.

Variety Swim Experience: Anchorage off Sipanska Luka offers a beautiful introduction to swimming from the yacht, with calm turquoise waters and a sheltered island setting.

Included Excursions: Entrance to the Mljet National Park

Overnight in Mljet island, Pomena port.



DAY 3 – SUNDAY | KORČULA ISLAND

Medieval Island Beauty and Wine Traditions

Often referred to as **Little Dubrovnik**, Korčula is one of Croatia's most captivating island towns, celebrated for its impressive medieval walls, elegant limestone streets and beautifully preserved Venetian architecture. Widely believed to be the birthplace of the legendary explorer Marco Polo, the island has long been shaped by maritime traditions and centuries of seafaring history. Before arriving, enjoy another refreshing Variety Swim Experience as your Captain anchors in the crystal-clear Adriatic, offering the perfect opportunity to swim directly from the yacht or simply relax on deck while admiring the island's picturesque coastline. Spend the day exploring the charming Old Town at your own pace, discovering hidden alleyways, boutique shops and inviting waterfront cafés, or join our optional wine experience to sample the authentic flavours of the island: Korčula is renowned for producing some of Croatia's finest indigenous wines, including the rare Grk grape, grown almost exclusively in nearby Lumbarda, alongside the celebrated Pošip variety that has become synonymous with Dalmatian winemaking. Travel through Korčula's picturesque countryside to the charming village of Lumbarda, home to celebrated family-owned wineries. Meet local winemakers and discover generations of island tradition while sampling four exceptional wines accompanied by homemade Dalmatian delicacies, including local prosciutto, sheep's cheese and freshly baked bread.

DAY 4 – MONDAY | LASTOVO ISLAND

Off the Beaten Path

Remote, quiet and beautifully preserved, Lastovo is one of the Adriatic's best kept secrets and offers a very different feeling from Croatia's better-known islands. Protected as a Nature Park, more than 70% of the island is covered by dense Mediterranean forest, creating a landscape of pine-covered hills, secluded coves and crystal-clear waters. Here, time seems to slow down, offering a glimpse of the Adriatic as it once was. After a refreshing morning swim stop from our yacht and lunch onboard, join one of our optional experiences or wander through the charming hilltop village,

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admire its distinctive stone architecture, centuries-old churches and traces of Venetian influence, or simply enjoy the peaceful atmosphere that makes this hidden gem one of Croatia's best-kept secrets. This evening, enjoy dinner at your leisure in one of Lastovo's welcoming family-run konobas, where freshly caught seafood, locally produced wines and traditional Dalmatian recipes celebrate the authentic flavours of the island. Your Chief Experience Officer will be delighted to recommend some of their favourite local restaurants.

Variety Swim Experience: Enjoy a swim opportunity in some of the clearest and least crowded waters of the itinerary.

Optional excursions: Fishermen of Lastovo and Lastovo Village, Wine and Traditions.

DAY 5 – TUESDAY | VIS

An island lost in time

Long closed to foreign visitors during the Yugoslav era due to its strategic military importance, Vis has preserved an authenticity rarely found elsewhere along the Croatian coast, making it one of Croatia's most fascinating island discoveries. Spend the afternoon exploring at your own pace or join one of our carefully curated optional experiences to discover Vis' fascinating military history, spectacular panoramic viewpoints or renowned local wineries. Return to the yacht in the evening and enjoy dinner onboard as Callisto remains overnight in the picturesque harbour of Komiža.

Sailing on towards Hvar, we sail by the beautiful Pakleni island archipelago which is known for its pine-covered islets and stunning secluded bays with crystal clear water. You will enjoy another Variety Swim Experience followed by lunch onboard, before arriving in the island of Hvar, providing the itinerary's most glamorous Croatian island experience and renowned for its Venetian architecture, vibrant waterfront promenade and impressive hilltop fortress overlooking one of the Adriatic's most beautiful harbours. Spend the afternoon exploring at your own pace or join one of our included and optional experiences before returning to the yacht for an overnight cruise towards Montenegro.

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Often referred to as Croatia's sunniest island, Hvar has welcomed travellers for centuries with its rich maritime history, lavender fields, excellent wines and sophisticated Mediterranean lifestyle. From its charming stone streets to its panoramic coastal views, Hvar perfectly combines history, culture and natural beauty, making it one of the highlights of your Adriatic island-hopping adventure.

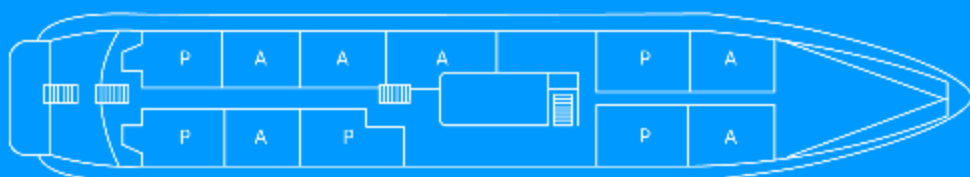

CABIN SPECIFICATIONS

The Callisto 17 outside guest cabins are located on Main and Lower Decks, with large portholes or windows. Elegantly decorated, they have either twin or double sized beds and bathrooms with showers en suite. All cabins are comfortably arranged and beautifully furnished with wooden furniture and light fabrics. Cabins have individually controlled A/C, offer storage space, and are fitted with flat-screen TVs, mini fridge, telephone (for internal use), hairdryers, central music, public address system and safe boxes.

LIFE ON BOARD

During the day, life on board centers around the indoor lounge area and dining room, as well as the outdoor areas at the Upper and Sun deck. Located on the Sundeck, the Library with its wrapped around windows is the ideal area to relax with a book, while engaging the passing scenery. The Captain will drop anchor at secluded bays and beautiful islands where, weather permitting, guests enjoy swimming, snorkeling.

Upper deck lounge & dining room

The lounge/bar and indoor dining room on the Upper deck are connected with each other by the gallery, displaying exquisite art and adding to the overall feeling of elegance and style. The classy dining room accommodates all guests at one single seating.
